Year 8-11 Term Exams & Year 12 Learning & Teaching

Our Year 8-11 pupils were recently issued with their Winter 2023 Exam Timetable (also available to download from the school website) which commences tomorrow. Full Learning and Teaching will continue for Year 12 pupils during the examination period for Years 8-11.



In recent years, some pupils have stopped attending school after their exams. Full learning and teaching for Years 8-12 will continue (where possible) up until 3.00pm on Friday 15th December so it is important that your child attends. After this date, pupils will be participating in activities and trips that have been planned for the last few days of term, although it is important to stress that some teachers may wish to continue teaching.
